

Government Orders sanctioning tender to the United India Insurance Co. Ltd.

ORDER

In the Government Order read as first above, Government had issued orders for implementation of RSBY, the Health Insurance Scheme for BPL workers launched by Government of India and CHIS, the Health Insurance Scheme formulated by the State Government for the BPL families in the State who are not covered under RSBY and Non-BPL families. A separate agency namely Comprehensive Health Insurance Agency of Kerala (CHIAK) was formed for the implementation of these Schemes. As per the G.O. second cited above, Government had authorised the Executive Director, CHIAK to initiate necessary steps for carrying out the Tender process for the implementation of the above schemes for the year 2010-2011. Accordingly competitive quotations were invited from Insurance Companies (Licensed and registered with IRDA) or agencies dealing with Health Insurance for implementation of Rashtriya Swasthya Bima Yojana for BPL families (Absolute poor) as per Planning Commission's guidelines and for similar facilities for such other poor families as are not eligible for benefits under RSBY but are identified and funded by the State Government as beneficiaries under category (a) of Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme (CHIS) and those who opt to subscribe the scheme by paying the full insurance premium and such other charges as prescribed to beneficiaries under category (b) of the Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme for all 14 districts of the State of Kerala.

2) The tender notification was published in 4 dailies, namely Malayala Manorama, Mathrubhumi, Deshabhimani and the Hindu. Tender Bids were received from the following 7 Companies:

3) The Tender Evaluation Committee constituted as per the Government Order 3rd read above to evaluate the Technical Bids met on 09/12/2009 and opened the Technical Bids. At the meeting held on 21/12/2009 the Committee completed its evaluation of the Technical Bids. The Committee decided that the Companies which scored Fifty marks and above may be declared successful in the Technical Bid evaluation. Accordingly M/S Oriental Insurance Company Limited and M/S United India Insurance Company Limited were declared successful in the Technical Bid Evaluation. The financial Bid submitted by the above two companies were opened in the presence of the representatives of respective Insurance Companies. The Oriental Insurance Company quoted Rs. 497 (without ST) & Rs. 548 (with ST). The United India Insurance Company quoted Rs. 421 (without ST) & Rs. 464 (With ST).

4) The Committee found that the Bid submitted by United India Insurance Company Limited is substantially responsive and the lowest evaluated Bid. The United India Insurance Company Limited agreed to include implant removal, Dialysis, Angiogram, Angioplasty and CABG in the Common Medical and Surgical interventions/procedures list .

5) The United India Insurance Company had also agreed to provide personal accident coverage to the Head of the Family and spouse for a sum of Rs. 50000/- for accident death and Rs. 50000/- to the head of the family or spouse in cases of accidental burns (exceeding 60%) not resulting in death.

6) After a careful consideration of the relevant factors, the Committee recommended Government to accept and award the Tender to United India Insurance Company Limited for the implementation of RSBY and CHIS in all the 14 districts of the State, for the next three years, subject to renewal on yearly basis, based on parameters fixed by the State Government/CHIAK for renewal.

7) Government, after considering the matter in detail on the basis of the recommendation of the Tender Committee, Tender documents, guidelines for implementation of RSBY etc. are pleased to award the Contract for implementation of RSBY and CHIS in all the 14 districts of the State to the United India Insurance Company at the rates noted in para 3 above for a period of three years from 01/04/2010 subject to renewal on yearly basis as the Bid submitted by the said Company is found to be substantially responsive, lowest evaluated bid and the Company is qualified to perform the Contract satisfactorily.

8) The Executive Director, CHIAK will move Government of India, Ministry of Labour and Employment for their approval/clearance in this regard.
